

## IN-TERM SWIMMING LESSONS – TERM 4

In-term swimming lessons will be held at the Rockingham Aquatic Centre for all students from Pre-Primary to Year 6. Students will participate in consecutive lessons, commencing on **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2017** and concluding on **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2017**.

### COST

The cost for the series of lessons will be \$35 per student, which covers the cost of bus fares and pool entry. You can pay for your child's swimming lesson in three ways; via **QKR app**, direct deposit or cash.

### LUNCH ARRANGEMENTS

Due to the swimming times available we have had to make some changes to when our students will eat lunch. Please note the following changes for:

- C2, D3 and A3 will eat their lunch at 1.30 pm.
- A4, C4 and E2 will eat their lunch at 12.30 pm.
- All other classes will have lunch at the normal time.

### EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR SWIMMING

- Children are required to wear their school uniform to school.
- Students are to please bring bathers, **two** towels, rash or t-shirt, jumper or dressing gown and thongs or sandals (**please label all clothing**) in a labelled plastic bag.
- Students will change into their swimming gear before they board the bus for their lesson. Footwear must be worn to the pool. One towel is to be left at school.
- Students are to change back into their school uniform upon their return to school.
- Classroom teachers will organise collection of medication from the office for relevant students participating in lessons.

**Interm swimming lessons are part of the Health and Physical Education Curriculum offered by the Education Department of Western Australia. All students are expected to attend.**
