Voluntary School Contributions and Charges 2023

Our 2023 Voluntary Contributions and Charges are listed below. We hope this will be helpful when calculating costs for the coming school year.

Voluntary Contributions

For 2022, we have kept our Voluntary Contribution at \$60.00 per year for Kindergarten to Year 6 students. The total Voluntary Contribution amount is within the student maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning programmes is maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments.

Excursion & Incursion Activities 2023
